VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: School-Year Camp Counselor-in-Training (CIT) or Junior Counselor-in-Training (JCIT)

LOCATION: Maryland SoccerPlex & Adventist HealthCare Fieldhouse, Boys, MD

TIME: Positions are available during our **School's Out Camps**, which are held on non-instructional school days throughout the school year.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Maryland SoccerPlex provides the **School's Out All-Sports Camp** on non-instructional school days during the school year. CIT's & JCIT's help prepare for and support camp activities, work directly with children, and provide additional assistance throughout the camp day. CITs are people-oriented and take pride in their role as representatives of the Maryland SoccerPlex.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist camp staff with daily camp activities.
2. Help ensure a safe and enjoyable learning experience for campers.
3. Play and engage with campers during activity and free time.
4. Assist with setup before camp and cleanup at the end of camp.
5. Lead or assist with games, arts & crafts, and other activities.
6. Prepare activity and craft materials, as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Enjoy working with children.
2. Strong communication skills; good command of the English language (other language proficiencies welcome).
3. Ability to work well with a diverse group of children and staff.
4. Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
5. Ability to follow directions with accuracy and attention to detail.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Minimum age 14 years (or entering 9th grade) to serve as a CIT.
 - o Youth ages 13 or in 8th grade may apply as **Junior CITs**.
2. Basic skills and interest in sports, arts, or general youth programming.
3. References appreciated.
4. Ability to commit to a pre-arranged volunteer schedule.
5. Camp staff shirt and name tag must be worn (provided by facility).
6. Proof of COVID vaccination.

TRAINING:

On-the-job training will be provided by the senior camp staff.

This is a rewarding opportunity to work with children in a fun, camp setting. The experience helps students build leadership, communication, and teamwork skills.
